

After School Karate

Loudonville PTA is once again offering an 8 week after school Karate program. The program is designed to teach the children skills that relate to areas such as perseverance, integrity, modesty and self control, as well as self-defense techniques.

Class size is limited to 20 and the class will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. This class is being offered to 1st – 6th graders.

- The program will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning Tuesday, January 19, 2010. Classes will be offered Jan 21, 26 and 28th. February 2, 4, 9, 11, 23, and 25th. March 2, 4, 9, 11, 16, and 18th.
- Classes will start directly after school and go until 4:30.
- The cost will be \$70/student.
- There is a \$25.00/student registration fee (includes uniform).
- \$15.00 test fee (when child is ready for new belt advancement).

Classes will be taught by Mr. Glenn Ward, 4th Degree Black belt with assistance from an adult assistant teacher. Mr. Ward owns and operates Kensho-Do Karate located at Siena College and the Duanesburg Area Community Center (DACC). Mr. Ward began his martial arts training while attending Siena College and subsequently graduating in 1986. Upon graduation, Mr. Ward began teaching the classes at Siena while over-seeing all aspects of the youth programs for his instructor's schools located in Albany, NY. Mr. Ward currently teaches or oversees the children's programs at Siena and DACC.
