Any data remnants must be purged or sanitized through the removal of all data from all systems and storage devices with the intent that the data can not be reconstructed by any known technique.

For magnetic media, the vendor must follow the National Security Agency security standard for degaussing equipment, which requires degaussers to reduce a special worst-case analog test signal by 90 decibels (db). More simply stated, degaussing must reduce the test signal to one billionth (1 part in 10<sup>9</sup>) of its original strength.

The **vendor must provide documentation** that guarantees the destruction of the information, and the method used.
