I understand that the rental cost does not cover the replacement cost of any equipment not returned to the Jiminy Peak Rental Shop, including lost, misplaced or stolen equipment.

1. I accept, AS IS, the equipment listed on this form and accept full responsibility, for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession. I will be responsible for the replacement at full retail value, of any equipment rented under this form, but not returned to the rental shop. I agree to return all rental equipment by the agreed date.
2. I understand the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times and under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, cross-country skiing and Snow Blade use, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.
3. I understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, SnowBlade and other recreational activities involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death that may result from skiing/snowboarding/SnowBlade use, or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment.
4. I AGREE TO RELEASE Jiminy Peak Mountain Resort, LLC., it's employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors and the manufacturers and distributors of this equipment (collectively called "PROVIDERS") from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding/SnowBlade use, or is in any way related to the use of this equipment, including all liability which results from the NEGLIGENCE of PROVIDERS, or any other person or cause.
5. I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of this equipment.
6. This agreement is governed by the applicable law of this state or province. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

DO'S AND DON'TS OF THE SHAKER HIGH SKI CLUB:

SKIERS SHALL:

- *Be on time for school the following day - if not, you do not ski the following week
- *Follow proper ski etiquette at all times
- *Follow proper safety rules and regulations - Jiminy Peak's and Shaker's
- *Be at school ten minutes before departure time (4:20 p.m.); the bus waits for no one
- *Be responsible for all items left on the bus
- *Use Walkmans only on the bus; they are outlawed in Mass. for ski use
- *You must ride to and from the mountain on the same bus. No switching or private rides will be allowed
- *Report all injuries to chaperones
- *Clean the bus when leaving
- *Instruct parents to pick student up at 10:00 p.m. after skiing

SKIERS SHALL NOT:

- *Be late to school the day after a ski trip (an unexcused tardy will result in forfeiture of the following week of skiing)
- *Use or bring portable stereos
- *Smoke - NO SMOKING ALLOWED
- *Be under the influence of drugs or alcohol - before, during and after skiing
- *Put on ski boots in bus or store them overhead on the bus
- *Lean skis on the side of the bus
- *Damage or destroy property
- *Use Ski Club as an excuse for academic failure
- *Transfer ski passes for any reason or use someone else's (theft)
- *Use other facilities at Jiminy Peak such as hot tub, saunas, pool

NOTE: Chaperones donate their time for you to ski; be cooperative with them.
